



■ Length of Cycle (years)


Number of Credits required per year





- National legislation:
 - Sunshine Act
 - open declaration of payments
- European legislation
 - not yet, but...
- The perceived need to be seen to be acting
- One last opportunity...



The Great RoI Debate

- Should we stay or should we go?
 - the benefit/loss analysis of disinvestment
 - the benefit/loss analysis of continued investment
- If we stay, how?
 - education or promotion
 - education or unrestricted grant education
- If we stay, and we fund/provide according to rules?
 - whose rules?
 - what sanctions?

 - Setting CME standards in Europe: guiding principles (2012)
- EFPIA
 - Code on the promotion of POMs to HCPs (2013)
- COCIR
 - Code of Conduct (2009)
- EUCOMED
 - Guidelines on interactions with HCPs (2008) and Q&A (2013)



Responses

- Learners
 - will need to accept transparency and accountability
- Providers
 - currently still have choices
 - to have it accredited, or not
 - to go for best practice, or not
- Funders
 - He who pays the piper, calls the tune (Beaumarchais)
- Accreditors
 - rigorous accreditation, or not

Agreeing the Rules

- All these codes, criteria and guidelines...
